INDIANAPOLIS, DECEMBER 2, 2011 – Two [Schmidt Associates](#) projects won awards in the 34th Annual Monumental Affair Awards competition sponsored by Keep Indianapolis Beautiful, Inc.

The Eugene and Marilyn Glick [Indiana History Center](#) renovation project received an award of merit in the interior design category. Judging criteria in the category are based on a project's responsiveness to the owner's needs and objectives, creativity, design concept, space planning, use of materials, use of furnishings, cost control and integration with architecture. Schmidt Associates designed the Indiana History Center's interior renovation for retail space and the Indiana Experience exhibit area which opened in March 2010.



[3 Mass Condos](#) received an achievement award in the downtown development category. Judging criteria included the project's architecture, landscape architecture, interior design, construction and the project's importance and significance to downtown. The building is a stylish downtown Indianapolis condominium development at 333 Massachusetts Avenue in the heart of the Mass Ave Cultural District. It features contemporary design that honors historical characteristics of adjacent buildings and promotes environmental sustainability via a green roof that holds less heat and absorbs and gradually releases rainwater.
